# Lemon Tree Resort, Thimphu, Bhutan

### Introduction

Nestled in the eastern Himalayas, Bhutan a landlocked country in the Eastern Himalayas, is known for its natural beauty, cultural richness, spiritual serenity and a unique blend of ancient traditions and modernity. It shares borders with China to the north and India to the south. It is the only country in the world that measures the Gross National Happiness (GNH) of its citizens, an alternative to GDP that the rest of the world uses to measure economic and moral progress.

Bhutan's capital, Thimphu, is in the western part of the country and is home to numerous monasteries, dzongs (fortresses), and chortens (stupas). This is the most modern city in Bhutan and offers facilities such as shopping centers, cafes, restaurants, and hotels. The city does not have traffic lights; instead, policemen direct traffic at major intersections, a unique feature that adds to its charm.

Travellers can explore popular tourist destinations and various attractions such as the Buddha Dordenma Statue, a gigantic Buddha statue overlooking the city, and the Folk Heritage Museum, which showcases Bhutanese culture and rural life.

Lemon Tree Resort, Thimphu, Bhutan, seamlessly blends with the surrounding forest, reflecting the country's harmonious connection with nature. # Local Sightseeing

The property can organise visits to many tourist destinations, including:

**National Memorial Chorten** – The National Memorial Chorten, located in the capital city of Thimphu, is one of Bhutan's most iconic and sacred landmarks. It serves as a daily place of worship for many Bhutanese. Both locals and visitors circumambulate the chorten, spinning prayer wheels and reciting mantras to seek blessings and peace.

**Buddha Dordenma statue** – The peaceful town of Thimphu houses a towering 51-metertall Buddha Dordenma statue entirely made of steel and covered in gold plating. At night, the illuminated statue becomes even more captivating. This statue is only about 12 kms away from the resort.

**Simtokha Dzong** – It is one of the oldest and most historically significant dzongs in the country. Today, it houses the Institute for Language and Cultural Studies, preserving Bhutan's rich cultural heritage and linguistic traditions.

**The Royal Textile Academy** – It features a museum highlighting exquisite handwoven textiles, provides educational programmes and training for weavers, and fosters the continuation of Bhutan's rich textile heritage.

**Motithang Takin Preserve** – It preserves a variety of native flora and fauna, making it a popular destination for nature enthusiasts and wildlife lovers.



**Simply Bhutan**– Simply Bhutan is a living museum and cultural center dedicated to preserving and showcasing the traditional Bhutanese way of life. Visitors can experience authentic Bhutanese culture through interactive exhibits, demonstrations, and workshops.

**Tashichho Dzong -** Tashichho Dzong is an excellent representation of ancient Buddhist architectural prowess. Located about 6.3 kms away from the hotel, this place holds great spiritual and cultural importance as it hosts the country's grand Tshechu (annual religious festival in the district on the tenth day of the lunar calendar) celebrations.
