n IIT Delhi and an IIM Kolkata alumnus, Patanjali Keswani is the CMD of Lemon Tree Hotels. Overseeing an aggressive expansion plan at the company, Patu (the name he is more known by) has successfully steered the group he promoted in 2002 to where it is now - 25 hotels in 15 locations aggregating 2,800 rooms. By 2017-18, he expects to have over 5,000 rooms across 30 hotels – given that earlier this year – he successfully secured a second round of funding when Dutch pension fund APG raised its stake in LTH to 13%. While the properties themselves have won a number of awards, what stands out is Patu's penchant for philanthropy and the recognition he has received with the 'Best Employer-National Award 2011' given by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment. Patu has also received the 'Hall of Fame Award' in 2011 from the Federation of Hotels & Restaurants Association of India and also from Hotelier India in 2011. A "thought leader" in the industry, Patu is also the chairman for the Sector Skills Committee for Hospitality, Travel & Tourism for the National Skills Development Corporation, and a member of the University Grants Commission. His immediate past assignment was as senior VP and COO of the Taj Group of Hotels. He worked with the TATA Group for over 15 years and was also director af A.T. Kearney for a couple of years, based in New Delhi.

attan Keswani needs no introduction to the trade or to those many even outside the trade.
